PGR2 Submission Deadlines

Four PhD Intakes Per Year: 1st Feb, May, July, Oct

Final PGR2 to PGRO <u>four weeks</u> prior to intake – except for Feb intake (deadline 15th Dec)

- Apply any time

2. AUT Doc Scholarships

- Open to anyone
- Apply 3 times per year
